

Tenure Track Faculty Position in Earth Surface Engineering and Intelligent Geotechnical Systems

The Department of Civil and Environmental Engineering at Northwestern University invites applicants for a tenure track faculty position in Earth Surface Engineering and Intelligent Geotechnical Systems. Areas of interest include, but are not limited to, earth resource engineering; assessment and mitigation of hazards due to natural and/or anthropogenic seismicity; protection of coastal systems; multi-physics of soils, rocks and granular media; sensor technology; construction automation; remote sensing and monitoring of geo-technical systems. Candidates at all levels will be considered. Applicants with an earned Ph.D. in Civil Engineering, or a related discipline, who possess strong teaching skills and the ability to establish a well-funded program of independent and collaborative research are encouraged to apply.

Applications must include a cover letter, curriculum vitae, statements of research and teaching interests, and a list of at least four names who can provide letters of recommendation. Application materials should be submitted to the search committee via the website. Review of applications will begin on October 31, and will continue until the position is filled.
